

Joe Barton Family Foundation Grant Guidelines 2019

Mission

The Joe Barton Family Foundation provides financial support to select charitable organizations in Texas to enable them to achieve aggressive goals that would have been otherwise unattainable. The intent of these projects is to dramatically improve the quality of life for the affected individuals, leading to better lives and stronger Texas communities.

Guidelines for Grant Seekers

Organizations seeking financial assistance must meet the following criteria:

1. The requesting organization must be designated as a 501(c)(3) organization by the IRS. The Joe Barton Family Foundation does not make grants to families or individuals.
2. The requested project funding should be designated for capital projects rather than operating funds.
3. The requested amount of funding from the Joe Barton Family Foundation should be \$25,000 or less.
4. The requesting organization must commit to raising funds equal to the amount of the grant from the Joe Barton Family Foundation.
5. The deadline for grant requests to be returned to the Joe Barton Family Foundation is Tuesday, July 30, 2019.

Evaluation Criteria

Used by the selection committee during the evaluation process.

1. Use of Funds - Capital projects will be given preference.
2. Special consideration will be given to projects that assist underprivileged children, low-to-moderate income senior citizens, abused women and/or children, or any project that helps people in need attain a better quality of life.
3. Project's overall impact to its community.
4. Ability of the organization to raise matching funds.
